The following agencies and contacts will help arts organizations to distribute free and reduced-price tickets as well as arranging for free transportation.

Neighborhood and Community Services (NCS): NCS manages childcare, teen, community, and senior centers throughout the county. [Complete this form](#) and email to NCSArtsFairfaxTickets@fairfaxcounty.gov to share key information about your program including date, audience, and number of tickets available and be matched with an agency. If the form is submitted at least 1 month prior to the event, NCS will provide free bus transportation.

Fairfax County Department of Transportation (FCDOT): The Fairfax County Connector serves arts venues throughout the county and offers free and reduced-price ticket programs including a [FREE Student Bus Pass](#) for middle and high school students.
